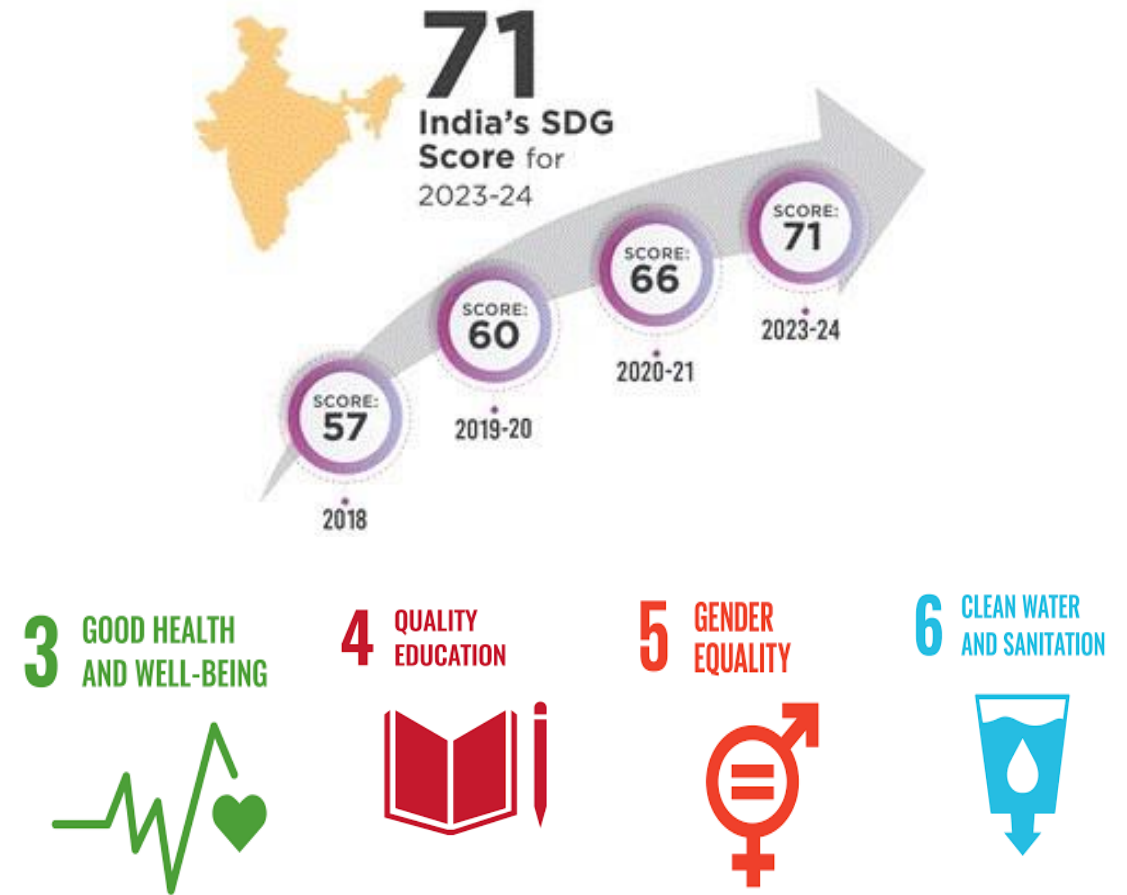

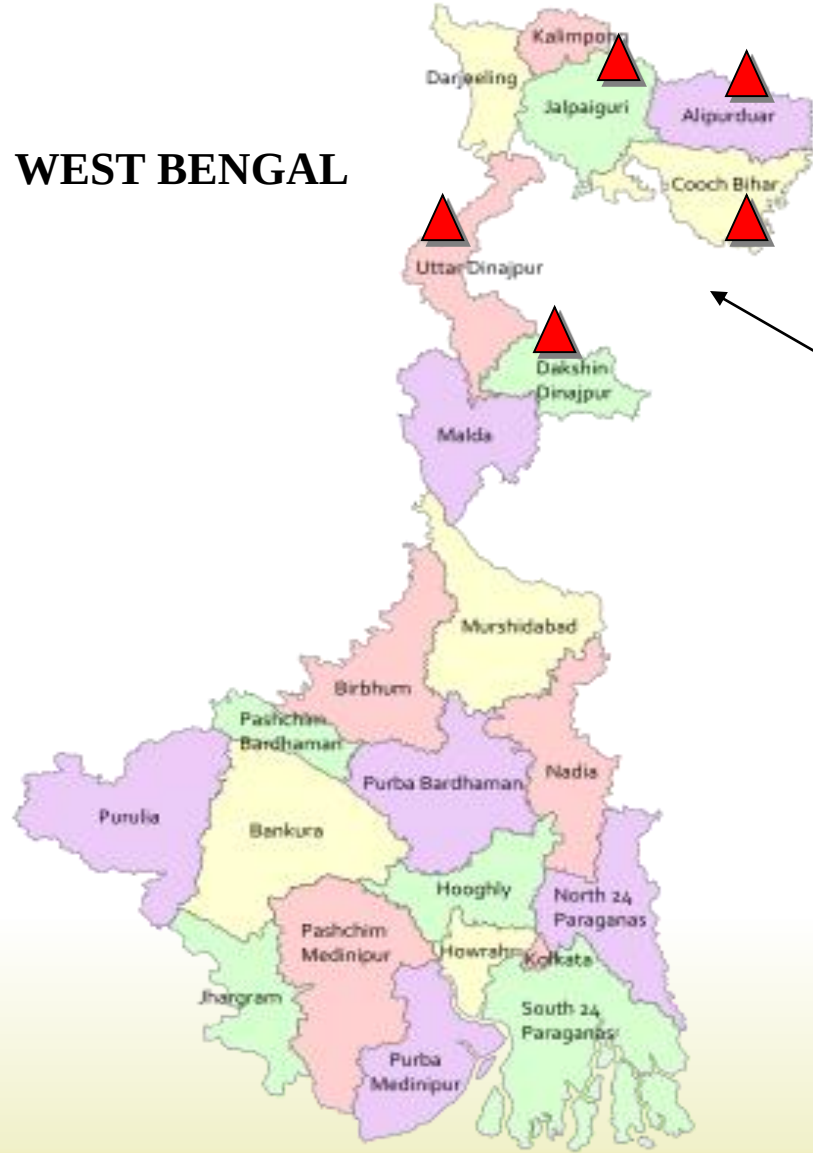

Mushroom Livelihood Development Program



This program trains participants in the cultivation, harvesting, and marketing of mushrooms, a high-demand crop that can be grown with minimal land and resources. Through hands-on workshops and expert guidance, the program equips farmers and small-scale entrepreneurs, especially women and youth with the skills needed to start and manage mushroom farming ventures. The LEDP (Livelihood Enterprise Development Program) on Mushroom Cultivation was successfully conducted in Five batches, focusing on empowering participants with the knowledge and skills required for mushroom farming. In each batch 30 beneficiaries were participated & total 150 beneficiaries covered under Projecting ventures.



Livelihood Development Program on Herbal Mosquito Repellent

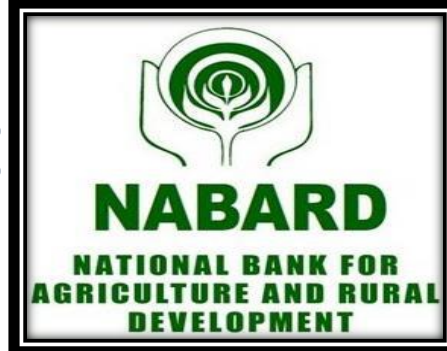


About our Founder
